- Referrals from social work departments – Athlone & Mullingar.

# Family Welfare Conference Service, Cavan Monaghan Meath

- Established in the 2003 Meath, Cavan and Monaghan,
- Part of core service provision in the regions
- Family based decision making, partnership, collaboration
- Integrated interagency collaboration
- Supports children to remain in the care of their own families – where possible
- Model based on international best practice – originated in New Zealand
- Consistently meets HSE defined performance indicators
